BIOSECURITY

Rats and mice carry disease. They get into on-board food stores, and can chew through gear or wires, creating a fire hazard.



Rodents are very good swimmers—they can land on islands even if you don't, and destroy wildlife.

Please check boats and gear are free of rats, mice, ants, seeds and weeds **before you leave** if planning to land or moor near any of the islands.
